

Title: Reported release of incorrect map of India by the Survey of India.

SHRI PAWAN KUMAR BANSAL (CHANDIGARH): Sir, law mandates that no one can publish a map other than on the basis of what has been published by the Survey of India. I have before me a series of advertisements issued by the Survey of India where the map of India has been incorrectly published.
