

Title: Regarding death of eleven activists of the Trinamool Congress Party in Khujutipara village in Birbhum district of West Bengal.

SHRI SUDIP BANDYOPADHYAY (CALCUTTA NORTH WEST): Sir, 11 Trinamool Congress members in Khujutipara village under Nanur Police Station in the district of Birbhum were brutally killed by CPI (M) this morning at 11 o'clock. ...*(Interruptions)* You please hear me for a moment....*(Interruptions)*

MR. SPEAKER: Nothing will go on record except the speech of Shri Sudip Bandyopadhyay.

SHRI SUDIP BANDYOPADHYAY : All of them belong to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and minority communities. They are being tortured and killed at random by CPI (M) people. It is a pre-planned and motivated attack. Our leader, Kumari Mamata Banerjee is leaving this afternoon to visit the spot, to attend the funeral and to console the bereaved families.

There is a Constitutional breakdown. Parliamentary democracy system in West Bengal is under serious threat. There is utter lawlessness.

MR. SPEAKER: The Law Minister is here. He is going to reply you. What is this?

SHRI SUDIP BANDYOPADHYAY : The hon. Home Minister is here. I draw his attention to this matter. This cannot be treated as a State subject.
