

Title: Need to take adequate steps to check erosion caused by river Fulhar in Malda district, West Bengal - Laid.

SHRI PRIYA RANJAN DASMUNSI (RAIGANJ) : Threat of erosion from river Fulhar is almost destroying the villages after villages in the habitation of Bilaimari G.P. of Ratua Block in the District of Malda for the last two and half year. More than 10,00 people have shifted their sites for living. Ramayanpur Rubimori and Janjaitola villages are at the verge of extinction. No comprehensive measures have been adopted by the Union and the State Governments, to protect the people and to make necessary arrangements to stop the erosion.

I draw the attention of the Government immediately for its intervention alongwith erosion of Padma in the district of Murshidabad which is causing severest threat for the change of demography border. Malda District Administration, unless are provided fund and technical assistance, they cannot rescue Bilaimari G.P. and, therefore, Mahananda Division of Malda District should be given support from Union Water Resource Ministry without further delay.
