Re: Need for computerisation of ticket reservation

DR. A.D.K. JAYASEELAN (TIRUCHENDUR): I would like to draw the attention of the Railway Minister. Sir, Tiruchendur is one of the major pilgrimage centres in southern India. It is one of the six abodes of Lord Karthik or Lord Muruka. Thousands of people visit this city to have 'darshan' of Lord Karthik every day. Since they come from different locations, they are not able to book their rail tickets as the reservation office at Tiruchendur has not been computerised yet. Generally, the people after travelling to Kanyakumari and other tourist centres go to Tiruchendur to have the 'darshan' of the Lord. In order to facilitate speedy reservation and also reservation from other locations, there is a dire need to computerise Reservation Office at Tiruchendur.

Hence I urge upon the Government to computerise the Reservation Office at Tiruchendur immediately.
