Title: Need to set up a modern science centre and planetarium at Kohima in Nagaland - Laid.

Shri K. A. SANGATAM (NAGALAND): Nagaland is probably the second highest in literacy in the North-East of India and claims to have a good standard of education. The performance of schools and college are fairly compared to other States in the Country.

However, with the speedy development in the field of Science & Technology, specially in information & technology, various explorations and the solar system are still to be studied and discovered. In view of this, I would like to urge upon the Government of India to give more emphasis in the field of space & solar system and provide facility to the youth particularly to the school children to impart sound knowledge about the fast moving world. But, in order to do that, a Modern Science Centre and a Planetarium should be set up in the State of Nagaland.

I, therefore, urge upon the Government of India to establish such a project in Kohima, so that the youth of this State would get maximum exposure and get acquainted and familiarized with the space and solar system.
