h four others is one of the cases. The approach of the Government of India is very indifferent. It's also a fact that tampering of evidence has become a common feature in these cases. The bereaved families run from pillar to post for justice which is seldom met. A genuine demand has been raised to amend Merchant Shipping Act. 1958.

So, I urge upon the Hon'ble Minister of Shipping to amend the Act by adding the line "loss of life of any citizen of India".
