THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND MINISTER OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI PAWAN KUMAR BANSAL):
Madam, with your permission, I rise to announce that Government Business during the week commencing Monday, the 13th of July, 2009, will consist of:-

1. Consideration of any item of Government Business carried over from today's Order Paper.
2. Introduction, consideration and passing of the Appropriation Bill relating to the Demands for Excess Grants (General) for 2006-07.
3. Discussion on the Statutory Resolution seeking approval for the continuance in force of the Proclamation dated 19.1.2009 in respect of the State of Jharkhand, issued under Article 356 of the Constitution by the President, for a further period of six months with effect from the 19th July, 2009.
4. General Discussion on Jharkhand Budget for 2009-10.
5. Discussion and voting on Demands for Grants (Jharkhand) for 2009-10.
6. Introduction, consideration and passing of the Jharkhand Appropriation (No. 2) Bill, 2009.
7. Discussion and voting on the Demands for Grants for 2009-10 under the control of the Ministry of :-
 - (a) Agriculture
 - (b) Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution
 - (c) Human Resource Development

(1) Discussion on the present stage of monsoon and its effect on the farmers with special focus to Rajasthan.

(2) Discussion on the drinking water situation in India with special focus to the present situation in Rajasthan.

SHRI ADHIR CHOWDHURY (BAHARAMPUR): The following items may be included in next week's agenda:-

(1) Aila (cyclone) affected people in West Bengal need immediate medical assistance as malaria has assumed an endemic proportion including the immediate supply of mosquito nets which they are starved for.

(2) Food processing industry to be set up in the Central and Northern parts of West Bengal prosperous for fruit and vegetables.
