Title: Need to take steps to recover containers bearing chemicals and pesticides that fell into the sea after the collision of two ships off Mumbai coast.

DR. SANJEEV GANESH NAIK (THANE): MSC Chitra and MV Khalija-III, ran into each other off the coast of Mumbai on August 7, 2010 and the containers from the ship spoiled into the sea, leaking oil. Over 300 containers from the MSC Chitra fell into the water. The 'Chitra' had 1219 containers on board of which 31 held hazardous chemicals and pesticides. Upto now 60 containers have been recovered from the sea. Therefore, I would like to urge the Central Government to take necessary steps to recover the remaining containers from the sea to safe the sea environment.
