Shrimati Gayatri Devi was a member of the Third, Fourth and Fifth Lok Sabhas from 1962 to 1977 representing the Jaipur Parliamentary Constituency of Rajasthan.

Shrimati Gayatri Devi was a Member of the Committee on Petitions during the Third Lok Sabha.

A woman who earned international fame and recognition, Shrimati Gayatri Devi was also a pioneer in women's education. She served as the Chairman, Governing Council of the Maharani Gayatri Devi Girls Public School, Jaipur; Board of Trustees of the Sawai Jai Singh Benevolent Trust; Maharani Gayatri Devi Soldiers Welfare Fund; Board of Trustees of Sawai Ram Singh Shilpa Kala Mandir and of Jaipur Museum Advisory Council.

A committed social and political worker, Shrimati Gayatri Devi worked for the welfare of poor and advancement of the women folk.

A sports enthusiast, Shrimati Gayatri Devi held the office of President of the All India Badminton Association and the Vice-President of the All India Lawn Tennis Association. She was also a member of the Sawai Man Singh Club, Jaipur and the Delhi Golf Club.

A widely travelled person, Shrimati Gayatri Devi was a multi-faceted and charismatic personality. She has to her credit a book entitled 'A Gourmet's Gateway'.

Shrimati Gayatri Devi passed away on 29th July, 2009 at Jaipur at the age of 90 after a brief illness.

We deeply mourn the loss of our friend and I am sure the House would join me in conveying our condolences to the bereaved family.
