Title: Need to check soil erosion by rivers in northern parts of West Bengal.

SHRI MAHENDRA KUMAR ROY (JALPAIGURI): A large number of rivers flowing down the Himalayas and Bhutan Hills which pass through the districts of North Bengal especially Jalpaiguri, part of Cooch Behar and Siliguri are causing havoc to properties and human lives. Due to erosion, the people living along both sides of rivers namely Teesta, Kaljani, Torsa, Mohananda, Raidak are affected and losing lives and property. A large number of people of these districts namely Vivekananda Pally colony near Jalpaiguri town, areas in and around Siliguri along the river Mohananda, Apalchand village in Changmari mouza in Jalpaiguri district, Mekliganj, Magumari and Kuchlibari in the district of Cooch Behar are the worst victims of these onslaught due to heavy erosion of soil by the swift current of the river. Even some of the villages have been completely washed away.
