Title : Need for expansion and four-laning of N.H. 34 in West Bengal.

SHRI ADHIR CHOWDHURY (BAHARAMPUR): National Highway 34 originating from Kolkata is regarded as a lifeline for the State of West Bengal. In addition, it serves as a medium of trade and transport to North Eastern Region. But the fact is that N.H. - 34 which was built decades ago is not good enough to bear the load of thousands of vehicles plying on it.
