The Department Related Parliamentary Standing Committee on Commerce in its 100th Report on Detailed Demands for Grants 2012-13 has made 40 recommendations/observations. Action taken replies on 3 recommendations/ observations accepted by the Standing Committee, on 22 recommendations/ observations convinced the Committee and it does not want to pursue further, 5 recommendations/observations not accepted by the Committee and final action taken replies on 10 recommendations/observations are awaited.
