Title: Need to conduct CBI enquiry in suspicious death of former Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu.

SHRI P.R. SUNDARAM (NAMAKKAL): Thank you, hon. Speaker Madam. The entire nation is convinced and worried about the mysterious and suspicious death of our most beloved leader, former Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, Dr. Puratchi Thalaivi Amma.
