Finally, that student's mother, Nafees, filed a *Habeas Corpus* petition and in this *Habeas Corpus* petition the court also ordered that a comprehensive inquiry should be done about this issue. Unfortunately, nothing has been done. The student community is agitating on this issue. So, I urge upon the Government to firstly, find out Najeeb Ahmed immediately and hand over the case to CBI; secondly, ensure justice for Najeeb; and thirdly, punish the culprits. Thank you, Madam.
