Title: Need to provide adequate funds and infrastructure for Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana.

DR. A. SAMPATH (ATTINGAL): The Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) evoked high expectations from the rural people of the country. The demands for basic necessities including land, housing, drinking water, sanitation, electricity, roads and bridges etc. are coming up before the MPs. The MPLADS amount allotted to them is insufficient to cater to these needs. The declaration of Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana villages without adequate financial resources and sufficient co-ordination of the departments, agencies, PSUs and other bodies under the Government of India as well as the State Governments have created problems for the MPs adding to their dearth of time to look into the needs of their respective constituencies.

Even though this matter has been raised during the zero hour on 13.05.2015, no positive steps have been taken by the Government of India so far. Hence, I urge upon the Government of India to take urgent necessary steps for providing sufficient funds, adequate staff, facilities and co-ordination for the successful implementation of the Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana.
