Title: Issue regarding shortage of fund at the Murshidabad Centre of Aligarh Muslim University.

SHRI MD. BADARUDDOZA KHAN (MURSHIDABAD): Hon. Deputy Speaker, Sir, with due respect I would like to draw the attention of hon. Human Resource Development Minister through you to a serious problem that has arisen due to fund crisis at the Murshidabad Centre of Aligarh Muslim University.

The Centre established in the year 2010 and spread over 288 acres of land, is aimed at providing quality education in Murshidabad District at affordable fees. The Centre is committed to secular ideas and is providing education to all sections of the society. Currently the Centre is running three courses only due to lack of infrastructure.

It is learnt from the institution that an amount of Rs.107.8 crore have been sanctioned by Government of India, Ministry of Finance vide their letter No.MHRD3-9/2008 desk(u) dated 3rd June, 2013, out of which Rs.40 crore have been released. The amount released has almost been completely utilized and now the Education Centre is facing a financial crunch.

I would like to request the Hon. Minister through you, Sir, to have the remaining grant released at the earliest. Thank you.
