Title: Need to restart the airport in Salem, Tamil Nadu.

SHRI V. PANNEERSELVAM (SALEM): Thank you Sir for giving me an opportunity to speak on the issue of Civil Aviation.

Before starting my maiden speech, I would like to express my sincere thanks to our Tamil Nadu Chief Minister Puratchi Thalaivi Amma and my constituency people to elect me as a Member of Parliament from Salem. In my Salem constituency, an airport was constructed in the year 1993. At present, there is no scheduled commercial operation from Salem airport.
