Title: Implementation of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan.

SHRI KAMAKHYA PRASAD TASA (JORHAT): The Mission of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (Clean India Mission) is a national campaign by the Government of India, covering 4,041 statutory cities and town to clean the streets, roads and infrastructure of the country. It is India's biggest ever cleanliness drive in which three million Government employees and school and colleges students participated. It has turned into a national movement.

This mission is one of the biggest initiatives for the welfare of the people of India. But, the ground reality one year later, however, presents a very different picture, which indicates that the movement has had a minimal impact.

The present situation is that both rural and urban areas are covered very badly with garbage. We can see plastic bottles and plastic bags scattered on both sides of our National Highways. Even our tourist destinations are not spared.

The Government of India may issue instruction to every Gram Panchyat, town administration and urban local bodies to take this mission on a priority basis and make it mandatory.
