title: Need to give two additional attempts to the candidates who have appeared at the Civil Services Examination between 2011 and 2015.

SHRI DUSHYANT CHAUTALA (HISAR): I urge Hon'ble Prime Minister to give additional attempts to aspirants to appear at Civil Services Examination. Presently, the number of attempts is 6 and 9 for general and OBC category respectively. During the period of 2010-2015, a number of changes have been introduced in the syllabus and pattern of the Civil Services Examination. On this line, recently UPSC has made the Civil Services Aptitude Test of only qualifying nature and only the marks of Paper 1 will now be considered for ranking in the prelims, based on which candidates will appear for the Mains exam. When the aspirants prepare themselves for a particular pattern, the pattern is suddenly changed and as a result, the aspirants appearing at this examination since 2010 feel that it is the toughest examination of the country. Therefore, I urge Hon'ble Prime Minister to give two more additional attempts to those aspirants who have appeared at this examination between 2011-2015.
