PUNJAB CIVIL APPEALS' BILL.

The Hon'ble Mr. Grey introduced the Bill to make temporary provision for the decision of Civil Appeals in the Districts within the Licutenant Governorship of the Punjab. In doing so, he remarked that he saw no necessity for referring the Bill to a Select Committee for consideration and report, but proposed that it should be taken into consideration at the next Meeting of Council.
