Title: Need to set up a CGHS dispensary at Kannur in Kerala.

SHRIMATI P.K. SHREEMATHI TEACHER (KANNUR): Large representation in Central Government Services by Keralite needs no special mention. Due to the very nature of its transfer liability, personnel are serving at different places, including foreign postings. Presently, only two CGHS Dispensaries are located at state capital Thiruvananandapuram.

Since the Capital is geographically at the southern most part, officials of 13 Districts of Kerala remain virtually uncovered. The great inconvenience to an extent can be eliminated by provisioning a CGHS at Kannur. It will not only benefits Keralites, but also people from Mangalore/Coorg areas of Karnataka as well.

Keeping the above facts in view, I kindly request the Government to initiate the process of setting up of a CGHS Dispensary in my Parliamentary constituency Kannur for the benefit of Government Servants.
