Title: Regarding custom duty on silk.

SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA (KOLAR): Hon. Deputy-Speaker, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and West Bengal are the largest producers of silk with Karnataka contributing about 60 per cent. Most of the silk is being exported. Because of the reduction in duty by the BJP Government, farmers and silk reelers are suffering. When the UPA Government was there, the duty was increased from 10 to 15 per cent. I urge upon the Government to come forward to protect the farmers and silk reelers by way of MSP and incentive. Farmers and silk reelers are committing suicide. They are facing serious problems, especially in Ramanagaram, Sidlaghatta, Channapatna, Tumkur and entire south Karnataka. So, this is a very important issue. Only three days ago, farmers committed suicide. ... (*Interruptions*) I urge upon the Government to take necessary steps.
