Title: Need to take steps to dredge water reservoirs in Damodar Valley Corporation.

SHRI SUDIP BANDYOPADHYAY (KOLKATA UTTAR): Madam, this is in connection with flood situation in West Bengal. Around 2.50 lakh cusecs of water have been released by DVC without any intimation to the State Government due to which the districts which Prof. Saugata Rao has already mentioned, have been badly affected...
