Title: Need to use river-friendly techniques.

SHRIMATI RAKSHATAI KHADSE (RAVER): Rains falling on lands are drained into rivers running through lengths of catchments & finally discharged into seas in natural drain arrangements. Out of the total rainfall a part is absorbed in the land and the balance reaches the rivers. The absorption of water depends and differs from catchments to catchments and depends upon the land characteristics.
