Child Development Project Officers is conducted by the National Institute of Public Cooperation & Child Development (NIPCCD) at its headquarters at New Delhi and its three Regional Centres located at Bangalore, Guwahati and Lucknow. A statement indicating the State-wise, location-wise number of *Anganwadi* Workers Training Centres (AWTCs) for training of *Anganwadi* Workers and Middle Level Training Centres (MLTCs) for training of Supervisors is annexed.
