I, Chairperson of the Committee on Papers Laid on the Table of the House (2019-20), have been authorized by the Committee to present this Report on their behalf, present this Twenty Eighth Report in respect of delay in laying of the Annual

Reports and Audited Accounts of the National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and

Research, Raebareli, U.P.

2. In terms of the recommendations of the Committee on Papers Laid on the Table

in its First Report, Second Report (05th Lok Sabha) and Second Report (06th Lok

Sabha) presented to the House on 08th March, 1976; 12th May, 1976 and 22nd

December, 1977 respectively, the Annual Report and Audited Accounts of the

Organisation / company are required to be laid on the Table of the House within nine

months of the closure of accounting year.

3. The Committee considered the matter of delays in laying of the Annual Reports

and Audited Accounts of the National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and

Research, Raebareli, U.P. and took oral evidence of the representatives of the Ministry

of Chemical and Fertilizers (Department of Pharmaceuticals) and the Institute at their

sitting held on 27th December, 2016.

4. The Committee considered and adopted this Report at their sitting held on 22

September, 2020.

5. The Committee wish to express their thanks to the officers of the Ministry of

Chemical and Fertilizers (Department of Pharmaceuticals) and the National Institute of

Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Raebareli for furnishing the written replies,

other material/information and for placing their views in the matter before the

Committee.

REPORT

Delay in laying of the Annual Reports and Audited Accounts of the National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Raebareli, U.P.

The National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research (NIPER), Raebareli, U.P. an academic institution under the aegis of the Department of Pharmaceuticals, Ministry of Chemical and Fertilizers, Government of India, has been created as a centre of excellence for higher education, research and development in pharmaceutical sciences. The Institute started functioning in 2008 and presently offers M.S. (Pharm.) courses in three disciplines only i.e. Medicinal Chemistry, Pharmaceuticals, and Pharmacology & Toxicology. The status of funds released to NIPER Raebareli, U.P. for the last four years is given at Annexure-I.

- 2. In term of recommendations of the Committee on Papers Laid on the Table contained in Paras 1.16 and 3.5 of its First Report (5th Lok Sabha), Paras 4.16 and 4.18 of Second Reports of 5th Lok Sabha and Paras 1.12 and 3.6 to 3.8 of Second Report of 6th Lok Sabha presented to the House on 08.03.1976, 12.05.1976 and 22.12.1977 respectively, the Annual Report and Audited Accounts together along-with Review Statement of the Institutes/Organizations (Statutory/Autonomous Organization, Public Undertakings, corporations, Joint ventures, Societies etc.) are required to be laid within 09 months of the closer of the respective Accounting Year. To comply with this requirement proper time schedule should be laid down for compilation of Annual Report and Accounts and their auditing.
- 3. As per the provisions of Section 23(4) of the NIPER Act, 1998, the Audited Accounts of NIPER, Raibareli are required to be laid on the Table of the House within nine months of the closing of Financial Year.
- 4. The scrutiny by the Committee on Papers Laid on the Table reveals that the Audited Accounts of the NIPER, Raebareli for the years 2012-13 & 2013-14 were laid on the Table on 09th August, 2016 with delay about 31 months and 19 month respectively. Further, Audited Accounts for the years 2014-15 was laid on the Table of the House on 16th December, 2016 with delay of about 11 months. (Annexure-II).
- 5. The chronological sequence in respect of the finalization of Audited Accounts of the NIPER, Raebareli for the year 2012-13 to 2015-16, are given in (Annexure III).

6. The Ministry Chemicals and Fertilizers (Department of Pharmaceuticals) in their written note have submitted that reasons for delay in laying of the Documents as under

"Board of Governors (BoG) was yet to be constituted for the Year(s) 2012-13 and 2013-14. By the time BoG was constituted, Steering Committee for new NIPERs took the work in place of BoG. NIPER, Raebareli completed / presented the copies of the Annual Report for the year 2012-13 and 2013-14 completing the requisite formalities before the Steering Committee in its meeting held on 30th December, 2014. As such, the Statement of Annual account of NIPER, Raebareli were approved by the Steering Committee for new NIPERs. The Statements could not be prepared earlier as NIPER is functioning with the help of mentor institute and system took time to evolve. For the year 2014-15, NIPER Raebareli completed / presented the copies of Annual Report for the year 2014-15 completing the requisite formalities before the Steering Committee in its meeting held on 30th December, 2014. As such, the Statement of Annual account of NIPER, Raebareli were approved by the Steering Committee for new NIPERs. The Statements could not be prepared earlier as NIPER was functioning with the help of mentor institute and system took time to evolve."

7. As regard to the steps taken by the Ministry to curtail the delays in future, the Ministry stated as under:-

"the delays have principally been because NIPER Raebareli was running under the mentorship of SCIR-CDRI and its administrative staff has been managing the finance and accounts of NIPER-Raibareli. As they have their own responsibilities and priorities the account of NIPER consistently got delayed as far as audit of account and submission of audited report was concerned.

As the regular Director of NIPER has now been placed on November 1, 2016, these issues will be addressed and ensured in future."

- 8. In regard to the appointment of auditors for the purpose of auditing Annual Accounts of the aforesaid Institute during the aforesaid years, the Ministry stated that in few cases there had been delay in approaching the auditors for auditing and accounting by CSIR-CDRI staff.
- 9. As regards to any remedial measures to ensure timely laying of the documents in Parliament in future, the Ministry in written note submitted as under:-

"Newly appointed Director NIPER-Raebareli has been directed to get the auditing of the financial account done for the current financial year and the same has been completed. The points raised by the auditors are being addressed in collaboration with the staff of mentor institute CSIR-CDRI and final audited report is expected shortly. It will be ensured that the final Annual Report and Audited Report is submitted to the Ministry as soon as possible."

- 10. The Committee considered the matters of delay in laying of Audited Accounts of NIPER, Raibareli for year 2012-13 and 2014-15 and took oral evidence of the representatives of the Ministry of Chemical and Fertilizers (Department of Pharmaceuticals) on 27th December, 2016.
- 11. The Committee subsequently noted that the Audited Accounts for the year 2015-16 was laid on the Table of the House on 11th April, 2017 with a delay of four months. Further, the Audited Accounts for the year 2016-17 was also laid with delay of two days i.e. 02nd January, 2018 and the Annual Report for the year 2017-18 and 2018-19 were laid on 18.12.2018 and 03.12.2019 within stipulated time period.(Annexure-II)

Observations / Recommendations

- 12. While examining the Committee was apprised that the reasons for delay of laying of Audited Accounts of the National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research(NIPER), Raebareli, U.P. for the years 2012-13 to 2013-14, were due to non-constitution of the Board of Governors(BoG) for NIPER, Raebareli. Till such time BoG was constituted, Steering Committee for new NIPERs took up the work in place of BoG. NIPER, Raebareli presented the copies of Annual Reports for the years 2012-13 and 2013-14 completing the requisite formalities before the Steering Committee in its meeting held on 30th December, 2014. The Statements of Annual Accounts of NIPER, Raebareli were approved by the Steering Committee for new NIPERs. The Statements could not be prepared earlier as NIPER is functioning with the help of mentor institute and system took time to evolve. However, the Committee are satisfied to note that consequent upon efforts made by the Ministry/Institute, the Annual Reports and Audited Accounts of NIPER for the years 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17 were laid with delays 11 months, 04 months and 02 days respectively. The documents of the years 2017-2018 and 2018-19 have been laid within stipulated time period on the Table of the House. The Committee expect that efforts will continue to lay the documents of NIPER within stipulated time in future.
- 13. The Committee note with concern that NIPER Act provides for laying of only Audited Accounts, not the Annual Report and that the Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers (Department of Pharmaceutical) has not taken note of Parliamentary Committees recommendations and provision in GFR for laying of Annual Report and Audited Accounts together on the Table of the House within 9 months of closure of accounting year. The Committee urge the Ministry/Institute to ensure laying of both Annual Report and Audited Accounts on the Table of the House within the stipulated time frame.
- 14. The Committee also impress upon the Ministry that if due to unavoidable reasons, the Annual Reports and Audited Accounts of the NIPER, Raebareli could not be laid on the Table of the House within the stipulated time; a statement explaining the reasons as to why the requisite documents could not be laid within prescribed period should be laid on the Table of the House within 30 days or as soon as the House meets, whichever is later.

It was also informed that the work related to auditing of Audited Accounts of the NIPER Raebareli for the year 2015-2016 have been audited by the auditors and the replies to the queries raised by the Auditors have also been furnished by the NIPER Raebareli to the Auditors. After receipt of Final Audit Report, efforts would be made to lay the documents of the NIPER, Raebareli during the next Session of the House.
- 9. Thereafter, the Hon'ble Chairperson thanked the representatives of the Ministry and the NIPER, Raebareli for useful discussion in connection with examination of the subject.
