presented to cover its clauses. It was said that, in the Report of the Select Committee, it had been said that, if any change were made in the constitution of the Municipal body, it might be proper to republish the Bill. But though such change had been made, he did not, upon consideration, think that it furnished any sufficient ground for re-publication. It was to be remembered that the question of the best mode of providing for the appointment of Municipal Commissioners had been under agitation for the last three years, and several associated bodies who might be considered to represent the principal classes of the inhabitants, had, during that period, expressed opinions regarding it, and proposed schemes of their own. The Council had had an opportunity of considering these opinions and schemes, and had formed their own judgment as to the course which ought to be followed. It was not likely that their judgment would be affected by any thing that could now be adduced; and he saw no benefit, but rather the reverse, in a further agitation of the subject. The only other alteration of moment made in the Bill was as to the lighting-rate. The Bill had provided a partial lighting-rate on those streets which would be lighted with gas. That provision had been altered in Committee, the alteration being that there should be a general lighting-rate on the whole town, including streets lighted with oil as well as streets lighted with gas. The question of a lighting-rate had been even more agitated than the question of the formation of a Municipal body. When he had first suggested the introduction of a lighting-rate in the Gas Bill, he had provided that there should be a rate upon the whole town. The inhabitants then had had an opportunity of expressing themselves upon that provision, and had availed themselves of it. The Council had had before them the Petitions received; they had fully discussed the question; and the subject was now exhausted. He did not, therefore, think that, either as to the formation of the Municipal body or as to the lighting rate, there was any sufficient reason for the re-publication of the Bill; and he should at once move the third reading.

The motion was carried, and the Bill read a third time.

OATHS OF OFFICE.

MR. ALLEN moved that the Bill "concerning the taking of Oaths of Office, by

"Registers of Deeds" be read a third time and passed.

The Motion was carried; and the Bill read a third time.

MESSENGER.

MR. GRANT was requested to take the above Bill and the Bill "for appointing Municipal Commissioners and for levying rates and taxes in the Town of Calcutta" to the Governor General for his assent.

Agreed to.

NOTICE OF MOTION.

MR. PEACOCK gave notice that he would, on Saturday next, move the second reading of the Indian Penal Code.

CIVIL AND CRIMINAL PROCEDURE.

THE CLERK reported that he had received by transfer from the Home Department certain Papers, with the following Resolution adopted by the Government of India :

"RESOLUTION—The Right Honorable the Governor General in Council resolves that the first Report of the Law Commissioners, together with the Honorable Court's Despatches relating thereto, and the communications since received on the subject from the Lieutenant-Governor of Bengal, and the Judges of Her Majesty's Supreme Court, be forwarded to the Legislative Council with a view to the consideration of the recommendations of the Law Commissioners in respect to the forms of Civil and Criminal Procedure, and to the enactment of a Law in general accordance therewith.

"His Lordship in Council also resolves that the Code of Procedure, framed by Messrs. Mills and Harrington, and the papers therewith connected, and all other recommendations recently brought forward for the alteration of the present Law of Civil and Criminal Procedure in Bengal, be also forwarded to the Legislative Council.

"His Lordship in Council is of opinion that financial considerations render it at present impossible to sacrifice the large amount of revenue derived from Judicial Stamps.

"The Honorable Mr. Peacock has consented to prepare and bring in a Bill for giving effect to the proposed Codes of Procedure, with the exception noticed in the preceding paragraph.

"The question of amalgamating the Sudder and Supreme Courts, and the formation of a High Court, will be separately considered and reported to the Honorable Court.

SINGAPORE HARBOUR LIGHT.

THE CLERK reported that he had received by transfer from the Home Department copy of an extract of a despatch from the Court of Directors, approving of the expenses of the Light fixed on the Government Hill at Singapore being debited to the General Revenues of Singapore instead of to the Straits Light Fund, the Light being merely a local one, and affording assistance to such vessels only as enter or leave the harbor at night, and therefore not being a "Straits Light" to the establishment and support of which a toll is payable by every ship passing through the Straits of Malacca or Singapore. The Court suggest, however, that vessels entering Singapore Roads may be charged a certain rate of toll.

MR. ALLEN moved that this communication be printed.

Agreed to.

NOTICES OF MOTION.

MR. GRANT gave notice that, on Saturday next, the Chief Justice (who had been unable to attend to-day) would move the first reading of a Bill "to establish and incorporate an University at Calcutta."

MR. ELIOTT gave notice that, on Saturday next, he would move that the Council resolve itself into a Committee on the Bill "to prevent the over-crowding of Vessels carrying Native Passengers in the Bay of Bengal."

The Council adjourned.

A P P E N D I X.

STANDING ORDER ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 10TH MAY 1856, FOR THE ADMISSION OF REPORTERS FOR THE PUBLIC PRESS.

That ACCOMMODATION shall be provided for Reporters for the Public Press. An application for the admission of a Reporter on behalf of any Newspaper may be made by the Proprietor or Editor of such paper to the Clerk of the Council. The application shall be reported to the Standing Orders Committee, who may direct the Clerk of the Council, to issue an order for the admission of the Reporter named, which order shall continue in force until revoked.
