Respected Speaker Madam, I join the voices of anger that are being raised in the house. This house on the issues of terrorism and separatist activities was never divided on party lines earlier, nor it stands divided today nor will it ever be divided in the future. The house is totally entitled to unanimously express its anger, the way it has done today. I wanted to assure this house and the country that after the formation of the government all these activities are not taking place with government patronage nor does the government have any prior information about them.

We are among those who have seen the sacrifice of the likes of Shyama Prasad Mukherjee on such issues. So please do not try and teach us patriotism. I want to tell you that we have sought clarification on certain issues and like the honorable Home Minister said, once he receives clarification, he will make a statement in the parliament.

And so I reiterate, this is not the anger of any specific party, this is the nation's anger. This anger is not limited to any one side but belongs to the entire house. We express our anger against all the separatist forces, all those who support such forces and those who misuse the laws. In the days to come, we will take all possible steps to save the unity and integrity of the nation, for which this house is committed.
