TWENTY-SIXTH REPORT

(Presented on 2-3-1982)

The Business Advisory Committee held a sitting on Tuesday, 2 March, 1982.

2. The Committee recommend the allocation of 16 hours for General discussion on the General Budget for 1982-83.

3. The Committee also recommend that the Resolution regarding approval of recommendations made in paragraph 18 of Fourth Report of the Railway Convention Committee may be discussed along with the Demands for Grants (Railways) for 1982-83 and Supplementary Demands for Grants (Railways) for 1981-82 for which 5 hours have already been allotted.

4. The Committee further recommend that in order to find more time for General Discussion on the Railway Budget, Demands for Grants (Railways) for 1982-83; Supplementary Demands for Grants (Railways) for 1981-82 and the Resolution regarding recommendations of Railway Convention Committee, the House may continue to sit during lunch hour also on Wednesday, 3 March, 1982 and Wednesday, 17 March, 1982.
