 - (ii) discussion on the import of animal tallow may be taken up on Thursday, 22 December, 1983.
- 4. The Committee further recommend that the House may sit during lunch hour also from Wednesday, 14 December, 1983 till the end of the current session in order to provide sufficient time for completion of essential items of Government Legislative Business.
