The Business Advisory Committee held a sitting on Thursday, the 23rd May, 1957.

2. The Committee recommend the allocation of time to the following items of Government Legislative and other Business as shown against each item :—

3. The Committee recommend that on the 28th, 29th and 30th May, 1957, when the general discussion on the General Budget will be taken up, the House may sit longer by one hour each day if the Speaker so directs.

4. The Committee also recommend that the discussion on the State Bank of India (Amendment) Bill and the Reserve Bank of India (Amendment) Bill may take place together.
