

BUSINESS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

TENTH REPORT

(Fourth Lok Sabha)

The Business Advisory Committee held sittings on Tuesday, the 5th and Thursday, the 7th December, 1967, to reconsider the time recommended in their Ninth Report to the Official Languages (Amendment) Bill, 1967 and the Resolution on the Official Languages.

2. The Committee recommend that 22 hours may be allotted for (1) consideration and passing of the Official Languages (Amendment) Bill, 1967 and (2) discussion on the Resolution on Official Languages. Out of these 15 hours may be allotted for General Discussion, 5 hours for Clause by Clause Consideration and 2 hours for Third Reading.

3. The Committee further recommend that the House may sit also on Saturday, the 16th December, 1967.

4. The Committee also recommend that during the remainder of the current session Half-an-hour discussions might be fixed from 6 P.M. to 6.30 P.M.

5. The Committee recommend that subject to these changes the time to other items as recommended in the Ninth Report of the Committee except item (1) thereof which has already been disposed of by the House, be agreed to by the House.
