

FOURTH REPORT

(SECOND LOK SABHA)

The Business Advisory Committee held a sitting on Friday, the 19th July, 1957.

2. The Committee considered the Report of the Sub-Committee (Appendix) which held its sitting on the 18th July, 1957 and recommends the allocation of time to the Demands for Grants relating to various Ministries etc., as follows :—

(1) Ministry of Commerce and Industry	6 hours.
(2) Ministry of Transport and Communications	9 hours.

(10) Ministry of Health	2 hours.
(11) Ministry of Home Affairs	8 hours.
(12) Ministry of Irrigation and Power	9 hours.
(13) Ministry of Labour and Employment	6 hours.
(14) Ministry of Law	1 hours.
(15) Ministry of Rehabilitation and Minority Affairs	8 hours.
(16) Ministry of Works, Housing and Supply	4 hours.
(17) Ministry of Steel, Mines and Fuel	5 hours.
(18) Department of Atomic Energy	2 hours.
(19) Planning	6 hours.
TOTAL	101 hours.

3. The Committee recommend that two hours may be allotted to the No-Day-Yet-Named-Motion of Shri Harish Chandra Mathur regarding Interim General Plan for Greater Delhi.

4. The Committee further recommend that with effect from Tuesday, the 23rd July, 1957 till the conclusion of the discussion and voting on the Demands for Grants (General Budget) the House may sit from 11 A.M. to 5-30 P.M. every day.

5. The Committee further recommend that the House may sit on Saturdays, the 27th July and 3rd August, 1957.
