an objective mind, we try to analyse the situation and we try to see how we can really bring about the real electral improvement. It is not a futile exercise. So, real electoral improvement can only be brought about when we form our conclusions and when we share our thoughts with the Members of the Opposition. And I would once again register my sense of gratefulness to the hon. Members. I have benefitted by their views.

I am trying to conclude, beacause you were saying that otherwise it may strike twelve.

SHRIG. M. BANATWALLA : What about a word of assurance on the Bihar matter ?

SHRI JAGAN NATH KAUSHAL : You have brought it to the notice of the House. We have taken note of it.
