SHRI P. VENKATASUBBAIAH: I draw the attention of the Hon. member to the Action Taken Report It says:

"The Central Government have given earnest consideration to the Report and to the recommendacontained therein. observe that the recommendations made by the Commission raise important and complex issues which have wide and deep implications for the country as a whole. The criteria suggested for determining social and educational backwardness in Hindu communities and non-Hindu communities need to be carefully considered in consultation with the Governments and in the light of such views as may be expressed by informed public opinion. Similarly, the recommendations in relation to reservations, concessions and assistance need to be gone into against the background of the position obtaining in the different parts of the country, the instruments and goals of planned development adopted and other relevant factors."

This is the action we have taken. It further says as follows:

"In the light of the above, the Central Government have forwarded the Report of the Commission to the various State Governments for obtaining their views. On receipt of their replies the Central Government will give further consideration to the Report of the Backward Classes Commission with a view to formulating their views on the various recommendations contained in the Report."
