Government have decided to pay this instalment to the employees Payment change of instalment will cost this the cxchaquer Rs. 64.17 crores during the current financial year, the estimated cost of an instalment during a full year being Rs. 70.0 crores. Orders for the payment of this instalment will be issued shortly.

2. Under the existing arrangement, an instalment of Relief to the Central Government pensioners including family pensioners aslo becomes due for consideration after every increase of 8 poins in the average index. The last instalment of Relief was sanctioned on this basic with from 1,1.1982, when the average index was 440. Consequent on the average index reaching 450.99 points at the end of March 1982, a further instalment of Relief from 1.4.1982 became dué for consideration. Government have also decided to pay this instalment of Relief to the pensioners including family pensioners. This will cost the exchequer Rs. 5.50 crores during the current financial year, the estimated cost of an instalment of relief in a full year being Rs. 6 crores. Orders for the payment of this instalment will be issued soon
