UPENDRA): (a) The Doordarshan Kendras which put out programmes mainly in Hindi are those at Delhi, Lucknow, Jaipur and Ranchi. The names of AIR stations which broadcast the programmes in Hindi are given in the attached statement.

(b) It is the endeavour of the two elec-

tronic media to produce programmes to the extent possible in the language widely spoken in the areas which they cater to. At the same time, the national service, mainly in Hindi and English but also including programmes in regional languages, is dissminated to meet the requirements of the country as a whole by relay of centrally originating programmes.
