SHRI SHYAMNANDAN MISHRA: Please assure us that you will consider it after having heard the Home Minister.

PROF. MADHU DANDAVATE (Rajapur): Have you asked the Home Minister to make a statement?

MR. SPEAKER: The problem is that you do not listen. Only one thing can be done at a time, either shouting or listening. Both things cannot be done.

Business in this House during the

(3) Discussion on the Resolution

Trust Laws (Amendment)

Trust Laws (Amendment)  
Bill, 1975.

I may also inform the House that I  
had a meeting with the leaders of the  
opposition in regard to the timely dis-  
posal of financial business by the  
House and they have kindly agreed  
that with effect from Monday, the 10th  
March, 1975 till the passing of the  
Finance Bill, 1975 the lunch interval  
may be dispensed with. I hope the  
House will agree to this. I am moving  
a formal motion for the dispensing of
