### OBITUARY REFERENCE

**Mr. Speaker:** I have to inform the House of the sad demise of Pandit Govind Malaviya who passed away at 4 A.M. today at New Delhi at the age of 59.

Pandit Malaviya was a sitting member of this House from the Sultanpur constituency of Uttar Pradesh. He was also a member of the former Central Legislative Assembly during the years 1945-47; of the Constituent Assembly of India during the years 1946-50 and of the Provisional Parliament during the years 1950-52. All members who have had the opportunity of sitting along with him will kindly recollect that he was a bold

fighter and a good speaker. He was contributing much to the debates of Parliament. He was also the Vice-Chancellor of the Banaras Hindu University from 1948 to 1952 and used to take keen interest in educational and other matters.

We deeply mourn the loss of this friend, I am sure the House will join me in conveying our condolences to the bereaved family.
