Expert Committee on Delhi's Water Supply Problem

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (SHRI B N. KUREEL) (a) and (b). The Ministry of Health and Family Planning have set up a Committee to review the position of water supply to Delhi and suggest improvements to ensure that water supply is stepped up substantially during the summer months and is equitably distributed so as to avoid repetition of water scarcity in the next summer.

While no specific date has been stipulated for the submission of its report, the Committee is expected to submit the report as expeditiously as possible.
