World Bank Scheme for opening hospitals in Rural Areas

*920. SHRI K. C. PANDEY : Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING be pleased to state :

(a) whether the World Bank have prepared a scheme for opening hospitals in the rural areas of Uttar Pradesh and Mysore; and

(b) if so, the main features of the scheme and the progress made in its implementation so far ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING (SHRI D. P. CHATTOPADHYAYA) : (a) and (b). A Pre-Appraisal Mission of the World Bank has prepared a scheme for the intensification of the Family Planning Programme in the States of Uttar Pradesh and Mysore. It envisages the opening of additional Maternity hospitals, addition of Maternity Wings in selected Primary Health Centre and opening of more sub-centres. The matter is still under negotiation.

Merger of Safdarjang Hospital with A.I.I.M.S. New Delhi

(a) whether any final decision has since been taken on the proposal under Government consideration for merger of the Safdarjang Hospital with the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi ; and

(b) if not, when this decision is likely to be announced ?

THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND HOUSING AND HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING (SHRI UMA SHANKAR DIKSHIT) : (a) and (b). The matter is still under consideration.

Availability of Calories and Protein in an Average Indian Diet

*922. SHRI H. N. MUKERJEE : Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING be pleased to state :

(a) the improvement, if any, in the availability of calories and protein in an average Indian diet during the last five years ;

(b) how such availability compares with the international average and particularly the average in Afro-Asian countries ; and

(c) whether the export of certain items of our production that are important for the country's nutritional needs is carefully examined and to the extent necessary curtailed ?

THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND HOUSING AND HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING (SHRI UMA SHANKAR DIKSHIT) : (a) and (b). A statement is laid on the table of the Sabha.

(c) Yes, Sir. All the relevant factors are taken into consideration and the exports are regulated accordingly.
