- (a) whether the Union Government has received any proposals from the Government of Maharashtra relating to Housing and Urban Affairs sector;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof indicating the total number of proposals received and approved including the total number of proposals lying pending; and**
- (c) the time by which the Union Government is likely to give approval to the pending proposals?**

- (a) to (c) The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs facilitates and assists States/Union Territories(UTs) including Maharashtra, through its Missions/Schemes in development of cities and towns covered under these Missions/Schemes. Details of the proposals received and approved under the Missions/Schemes is given in the Annexure.**

Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation(AMRUT)

The Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs has approved the State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) for the entire Mission period costing Rs 7,759.32 crore including commitment for Central Assistance amounting to Rs 3,534.08 crore submitted by State of Maharashtra. There are no pending proposals of the State of Maharashtra under AMRUT.

Smart Cities Mission

Smart cities were selected through a Challenge process. In conformity with the Smart Cities Mission guidelines the State Government of Maharashtra submitted their Smart City Proposals(SCPs) for consideration during the All India Challenge. Based on the evaluation of the SCPs eight cities of Maharashtra –Pimpri-chinhwad, Nashik, Thane, Solapur, Nagpur, Kalyan-Dombivali, Aurangabad and Pune were selected for development as Smart Cities. No Proposal from Government of Maharashtra is pending with the Government.

Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban(SBM-U)

All proposals received for funding under the five components of SBM-U have been considered and Rs 857.99 crore released to the Maharashtra Government in conformity with the Mission Guidelines. No proposal of the State Government is pending under SBM(U).

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban

All 848 project proposals for 8,23,405 houses involving Central Assistance of Rs 11,234.89 crore have been sanctioned. No proposal of the State Government is pending under PMAY-U.

Metro Rail Projects

5 Metro Rail projects in Mumbai, Pune and Nagpur in Maharashtra with a total length of 137.15 Km. have been approved by the Government. Another 4 proposals from the State received during the last 3 years for a total length of 212.113 Km. Mumbai, Thane, Pune and Nagpur are under consideration in consultation with the State Government. Sanction of Metro Rail projects is an ongoing process which requires extensive consultations with all stakeholders, and hence, no time limit can be specified for the sanction.
