(a): Information relating to number of sportspersons shortlisted for Sports Awards by the Selection Committee and of sportspersons given awards is as below:-

- (c): Yes Sir. Ministry is implementing the Scheme of 'Pension to Meritorious Sportspersons' for providing lifelong monthly pension to medal winners of Olympic Games, Asian Games, Commonwealth Games, etc. after they retire from active sports and the Scheme of 'Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay National Welfare Fund for Sportspersons' (PDUNWFS)' for providing financial assistance to sportspersons of yesteryears now living in indigent circumstances.
- (d): At present, 627 sportspersons are getting lifelong pension ranging from Rs.12000-20000 per month under the Scheme of 'Pension to Meritorious Sportspersons'. Details of financial assistance given to sportspersons under PDUNWFS scheme during last 3 years and the current years (as on 25.11.2019) are as under:

(f): Other steps taken by the Government for welfare of the sportspersons include the facility of complimentary card passes given by Ministry of Railways to Arjuna Awardees, Dronacharya Awardees etc., which entitle them lifelong free rail travel for self and for companion on attaining the age of 65 years and provision of upto 5% reservation in direct recruitment in Group 'C' posts for meritorious sportspersons in Central Government.
