**FUNDS TO MEDICAL COLLEGE IN NAGALAND**

**1075. SHRI TOKHEHO YEPHOMI:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount of fund released till October, 2019 for Nagaland Medical College; and
- (b) the current status of the said college and time by which the college is likely to become functional?

(a) & (b): The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme namely, 'Establishment of new Medical Colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals'. Under Phase-I of this Scheme, one medical college has been approved in Nagaland to be established at Naga Hospital (Kohima) at a cost of Rs.189 crore to be shared between Centre and State Government in the ratio of 90:10. Complete amount of Central share amounting to Rs.171.10 crore has been released to the State Government of Nagaland for establishment of this Medical College. The State has reported progress of 16.50% on Ministry's Dashboard. The State Government has been requested to expedite the completion of this Medical College.
