Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether number of senior citizens in the country have increased over the years;
- (b) if so, the estimated senior citizens living in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has any proposal to start a dedicated employment exchange portal, namely, Senior Able Citizens for Re-Employment in Dignity (SACRED) for elderly;
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the features thereof; and
- (e) the time by which the new senior citizens employment exchange is likely to be started?

(a) & (b): The number of senior citizens in the country increased over the years. The population of the senior citizens during the last three census is given below:

(c) to (e): The Department of Social Justice and Empowerment has launched a portal named 'Senior Able Citizens for Re-Employment in Dignity (SACRED)' on 1st October, 2021, which provides an IT platform to bring the Senior Citizen employment seekers and the employment providers together. An individual senior citizen will get oneself registered on the portal with his relevant education, experience, skills and the areas of interest. Any job provider can also register on the portal. The interested and eligible senior citizens can apply for the job as per the matching criteria of his/her eligibility on the portal https://sacred.dosje.gov.in/.
